This brings up another point, the position of the preposition or particle. In Italian it is still at the beginning of the sentence, while in English we have placed it at the end, though, in the past, which is now considered archaic, it was at the beginning of the sentence:

To whom were you speaking?

Whom are you speaking to?

Who are you speaking to?

What are you looking at?

Who were you talking with?

What were you opening it with?
