

Answers

Do you remember how to form questions? (see questions) Then you will remember that we have four types:

- 1) $\mathbf{Va} + \mathbf{S} + \mathbf{Vp} + \mathbf{O} + \mathbf{C}$?
- 2) S + Vp + O + C, Va [with the opposite sense +/- than in the main part] + S [pronoun] +?
- 3) Q + Va + S + Vp + [O + C] + ?
- 4) Q + Vp + O + C + ?

For types 1 and 2 we form the answer in this way:

Yes/no + subject (pronoun) + VA [+ not, if the sense is negative]

Thus: Will you study tomorrow?

Yes, I will

No, I will not (won't)

Did you work yesterday?

Yes, I did

No, I did not (didn't)

Does he live in Catania?

Yes, he does

No, he does not (doesn't)

For type 3 questions the form of the answer is:

S + VP + [the object or the complement that is missing)

Thus:

Where did he go yesterday?

He went to Rome yesterday

When will they return?

They will return at half past five

Who does he work with?

He works with Mark

Why did she go to Palermo?

She went to Palermo to work
