### Collective Nouns

**E**ach of the components of the group is different but they are grouped together under one heading, they are never plural.

**advice**  
**knowledge**  
**baggage**  
**furniture**  
**information**  
**news**  
**rubbish**  
**traffic**

***P**eople and **police** are always plural: *The police are coming, there were many people there.**

**I**f the collective noun indicates people: *group, class, party, government.*  
These can take the singular or the plural depending if we think of the group as a whole or the individuals in the group.
