As Like

Like is used to mean *similar*.

As is used to mean *the same*

I work as a teacher (*I am a teacher*)

I work like a slave (*I am not a slave*)

You must buy some fruit, like oranges (here it is incorrect as like means similar but not the same, so it is impossible to buy oranges though mandarins are possible).

You must buy some fruit, as oranges (here it is incorrect as **as** means the same, fruit = oranges)

You must buy some fruit, such as oranges (*here the form is correct as such as means for example*)
