



MUST

Must is an auxiliary verb (see auxiliary verbs).

It only exists in the present tense:

1	2	3	4	5
-	<i>must</i>	-	-	-

Because this verb needs to be used in other forms, not only the present, we use the *To have to* form

1	2	3	4	5
<i>To have to</i>	<i>have/has to</i>	<i>had to</i>	<i>had to</i>	<i>having to</i>

Therefore:

I must go / I have to go

I had to go

I have had to go

I had had to go

I will have to go

I am going to have to go
