

Two Futures

In English if a sentence contains two phrases and they both have a future meaning, we do not use two futures, only one.

I will go He will come

We can join these two phrases together with one of these words or phrases.

When
As soon as
After
Before
If
Until
Till

I will go As soon as he will come

I will go as soon as he comes

The future becomes PRESENT

In the same way the Future Perfect becomes the Present Perfect

We will go to the cinema after we will have eaten

We will go to the cinema after we have eaten
