



Two Futures

In English if a sentence contains two phrases and they both have a future meaning, we do not use two futures, only one.

I will go
He will come

We can join these two phrases together with one of these words or phrases.

When
As soon as
After
Before
If
Until
Till

I will go
As soon as he ~~will~~ come

I will go as soon as he comes

The future becomes PRESENT

In the same way the Future Perfect becomes the Present Perfect

We will go to the cinema after we ~~will~~ have eaten

We will go to the cinema after we have eaten
