



# To have something done

The form of this is:

**S+[to have]+object+Vp4+[BY someone]**

This structure is similar to *The Passive*, but here the subject does not do the action, if the person who does the action is important than he is found at the end preceded by **BY**, just as in the passive. In Italian this is the **Far Fare** construction.

**I have my car serviced every year**

**I had my hair cut yesterday**

## To Say    To Tell

<b>To Say</b>	<b>Something</b>	<b>To</b>	<b>Someone</b>
<b>To Tell</b>	<b>Someone</b>		<b>Something</b>

To Say = *Dire*

To Tell = *Dire, Raccontare*

**Tell me something**  
**Say something to me**

**What did he tell you, he was speaking for hours?**  
**He told me nothing, he just said stupid things.**
