



# Present Tense

The form is : **S + V<sub>p2</sub>**

**R**emember that the **3<sup>rd</sup>** person singular takes the "S".

**W**e use the **Present Tense** to describe a **HABIT**, normally it is not happening now and we normally say when it happens.

Thus we can say:

*Present Tense = Habit, not now + when*

*I sleep every night.*

*You visit me once a year.*

*He works in the morning.*

*She plays the violin in her spare time.*

*We do the shopping on Saturday*

*We live in London*

*She plays the piano*

**I**n these two sentences we have the **Present Tense** but when it is not specified, this means **ALWAYS**, our house where we *always* live is in London.

She *always* plays the piano, this is her job, a piano player.
