

Past Perfect Tense

The form is: S + Had + Vp4

This tense is used to express an action that has taken place before another action in the Past, it cannot exist on its own, this action could be one that:

- i) Had just finished
- ii) Ha finished then
- iii) Had finished a period and could continue

The tense is used when we have a past action and another action that happened before.

Examples:

- i) I came here at 3 p.m., before I had eaten lunch.
- ii) I had seen the museum before I left the city

i.e. abbr. (of id est) cioè.

e.g. abbr. (of exempli gratia) p. es. (per esempio).
