Look – See – Watch

- **To See** – This indicates a general sense, the possibility of vision, it is used with CAN.
- **To Look (at)** – This means to observe, something that is fixed or moving in a regular way, there is no intensity in our observation.
- **To Watch** - This means to observe, but the thing is in movement or it will move, or, at least, something will happen

To Bring – To Take – To Get – To Carry – To Fetch

- To Bring – Means: To me, or with me.
- To Take – Means Away from me, from one place to another.
- To Get – Means: posses, obtain, buy, acquire, steal,
- To Carry – Means transport, not push or tow, lift above the ground.
- To Fetch – Means: to go, get and return
